New England Science and Sailing with Miss Megan: Marble Drop Challenge

On Monday, November 11th, get ready to lose your marbles! Discover what happens when two objects collide at increasing speeds. Engineer ramps that will speed up or slow down a marble as it collides with other objects or other marbles. Experiment with different size marbles and ramp lengths, try to stop the marble or change its direction, and try and knock down larger objects.
