School Snow Policy

Precious Memories Preschool of Sandy Hollow makes every effort to maintain operation during most weather conditions. All school closings or delays due to extreme weather conditions will be announced on television station NBC CT. We will also make every effort to change the center answering machine; as well as, post information on our website. In addition, our new snow removal service needs everyone to wear appropriate footwear through the snow and ice filled winter. They will not be responsible should someone slip wearing inappropriate footwear.

Gentle Reminder to Our Families

- If you have not had your child vaccinated for **INFLUENZA**, please make an appointment, and provide documentation to the main office. If your child has been vaccinated and you have not brought in documentation, please do so. Documentation must be submitted by **January 1st, 2024**. If your child is not vaccinated by January 1st, 2024, they may not attend daycare until they are vaccinated. If you have any questions, please see Administration. Thank you for your cooperation.
- We must stress the importance of picking up your children by 6:00pm. Late fee's will be implemented. Parents will be contacted at 6:00pm. If we cannot reach the parents, then the emergency contacts listed on your paperwork will be called. In the event we cannot get ahold of parents or emergency contacts, the local police department will be called.
- Please make sure you have appropriate (cold) weather attire in your child's cubby. We generally always go outside unless the weather does not allow us. Make sure you bring in snow gear for snowy days (hats, gloves, boots, snow pants, etc.). Please make sure all clothing is labeled.
- Reminder to please drive slow in the parking lot as our little friends are entering and exiting the school.
- On our Christmas trees in the front foyer, we love to put our families Christmas cards on the tree. Feel free to hand one into the front office so we can add your card to the tree.
