A Note From Our Nurse...

- * Here at Precious Memories Preschool of Sandy Hollow, our goal for all our little friends is to have happy and healthy days. It is a reality that sometimes children become ill and need to be sent home from school for a variety of health-related reasons. Our school has developed effective policies specifically related to sickness and appropriateness for the return to school. Our policy states that you may not return within 24 hours in cases of fever of 101.0 or greater, vomiting or two cases of diarrhea. Children may return to school after this 24-hour period and symptom free (WITHOUT using fever reducing medications). We want your children to feel well enough to take part in school activities and it is important to minimize potential contagion exposure to other children as well. We appreciate all of you for working with us to provide as healthy an environment as possible.
- ** As influenza season approaches, please provide documentation for your child's annual vaccine to the main office. Documentation must be submitted by January 1st, 2025. Thank you for your cooperation.

Reminders:

- Make sure your child's cubby has spare clothing. We no longer have a supply of spare clothing that we can offer. If your child does not have spare clothing and needs to be changed, we will be calling parents to bring clothing.
- Please make sure the main office has all up to date parent/emergency contact information for your family.
- We are a PEANUT FREE center- outside food that is not in the original package will not be allowed in the classrooms. Homemade food is also no allowed in the classrooms. Please see administration with any questions you have.
- Just a reminder that we do not allow backpacks or diaper bags to be left in the school. We understand that children proudly enter the school with their specially selected backpack carrying their belongings for the day and have no problem with this continuing. We do, however, ask that the parent/guardian unpack the backpack/diaper bag into their cubby and take the backpack/diaper bag with them as they exit the building.
- All children must be dropped off by 9:15am with the only exceptions being medical related or special unavoidable circumstances that have been approved by the Director.
